

SETTING UP YOUR SCREEN

TOOLS REQUIRED: Phillips Screwdriver


Carpenter's Level
Tape Measure

FRAME ASSEMBLY

- 1. Place the four frame pieces on a clean floor. The sides with the Velcro should face up.
- 2. Align the corner brackets with the slots in the frame and slide the frame pieces together (Figure 1). When assembling the last frame piece, slide both ends together at the same time to avoid binding the corner brackets.
- 3. Push and hold the corners together and tighten the four screws at each corner. Do not over-tighten the screws.

ATTACH THE VIEWING SURFACE


- Place the screen on the back of the frame assembly. Start at the top of the frame and attach the screen from the center working towards the sides. Look at the screen from the viewing side to make sure the Velcro is not visible.
- 2. Attach the rest of the screen in the following order. Bottom, left side, right side. Stretch the screen as necessary to remove any wrinkles.



SUGGESTED METHODS OF INSTALLATION

MOUNTING SCREEN TO THE WALL

- 1. Mount 1 or 2 hanger brackets as provided into the wall studs at the desired height. Use a carpenter's level to make sure the brackets are level. The top of the screen frame will be 1/8" above the top of the bracket when mounted. You will need at least 5/8" clearance above the bracket to hang the screen.
- 2. After the hanger brackets are securely fastened to the wall, hang the screen assembly on the brackets as shown in figure 2.



LIMITED ONE YEAR WARRANTY ON DA-LITE PROJECTION SCREENS

Da-Lite's sole obligation under this warranty shall be to repair or to replace (at Da-Lite's option) the defective part of the merchandise. Returns for service should be made to your Da-Lite dealer. If it is necessary for the dealer to return the screen or part to Da-Lite, transportation expenses to and from Da-Lite are payable by the purchaser and Da-Lite is not responsible for damage in shipment. To protect yourself against damage or loss in transit, insure the product and prepay all transportation expenses.
